

## 2 ALTERNATIVES ON HOW TO SET A DELAY (VBSCRIPT)

---

You could use 2 methods to set a delay in code, using VBScript: the "ping" or "sleep" approach.

### PING Approach

```
Sub subSleep(strSeconds) ' subSleep(2)
Dim objShell
Dim strCmd
set objShell = CreateObject("wscript.shell")
'objShell.Run cmdLine,1,False
strCmd = "%COMSPEC% /c ping -n " & strSeconds & " 127.0.0.1>nul"
objShell.Run strCmd,0,1
End Sub
```

### SLEEP Approach

```
Function MySleep(milliseconds)
set WScriptShell = CreateObject("WScript.Shell")
WScriptShell.Run "Sleep -m " & milliseconds, 0, true
End Function
```
