

## Excel - VBA - How to Save File & Automatically Overwrite Old File

### SCENARIO

I love the macro with the exception of one part: **I don't want to be prompted to overwrite the file if it already exists.** How can I change this macro so that, when pressed, it overwrites the file without prompting the user and waiting for their answer?

### SOLUTION

Application.DisplayAlerts = False

Set back to **True** after file is saved.

### EXAMPLE

```
Sub SaveIt()  
    Dim strFirst As String, strLast As String  
    ChDir "C:\Documents and Settings\All Users\Desktop\  
        !*****  
    Application.DisplayAlerts = False  
        !*****  
    With Worksheets(1)  
        strFirst = .Range("C4")  
        strLast = .Range("C6")  
    End With  
  
    ThisWorkbook.SaveAs _  
    "C:\Documents and Settings\All Users\Desktop\" & _  
    strFirst & " -TNT- " & strLast, xlWorkbookNormal  
        !*****  
    Application.DisplayAlerts = True  
        !*****  
End Sub
```
