


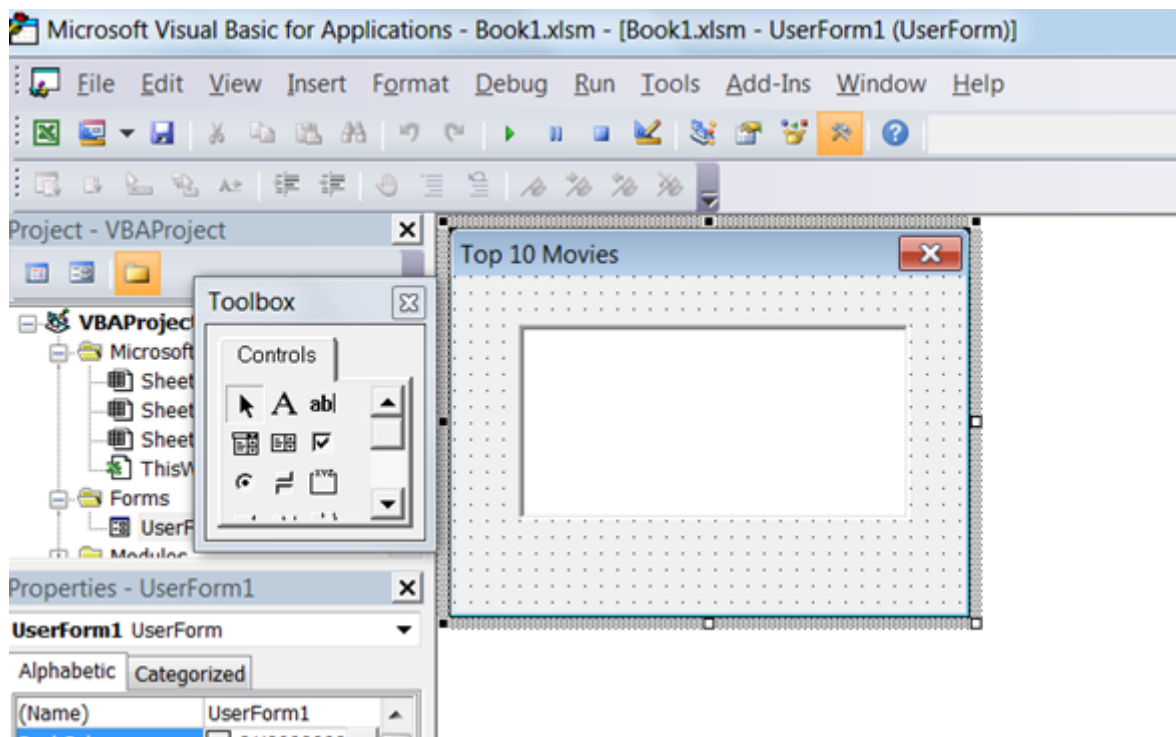
## Fill a ListBox from Excel Table using VBA / Populate a ListBox from Excel Table using VBA

Let us take a **Excel** table as shown below - a list of **Top 10 All time** hits.



Rank	Rating	Title	Votes
1	9.2	The Shawshank Redemption (1994)	6,39,762
2	9.2	The Godfather (1972)	4,98,879
3	9	The Godfather: Part II (1974)	2,99,043
4	8.9	The Good, the Bad and the Ugly (1966)	2,07,077
5	8.9	Pulp Fiction (1994)	5,94,339
6	8.9	12 Angry Men (1957)	1,53,810
7	8.9	Schindler's List (1993)	3,35,799
8	8.8	One Flew Over the Cuckoo's Nest (1975)	2,63,419

Let us assume that we need to populate the **ListBox** with values from **Column 3 (Column C)**...



The following code will help you populate the data:

```
Dim oWS As Worksheet  
Set oWS = ThisWorkbook.Sheets(3)  
Me.ListBox1.List =  
oWS.ListObjects(1).ListColumns("Title").DataBodyRange.Value  
End Sub
```
