Excel - VBA - How to use Non-Contiguous range of cells

Here is a way to update a range that is not contiguous using VBA (Visual Basic for Applications):

```
Sub NonContiguous_Range_Example()
Dim oRng As Range
Set oRng = Range("A1, B5, C9")
oRng.Value = "45"
oRng.Interior.ColorIndex = 34
```

End Sub

The output will be as shown below:
