

HOW TO VIEW SHARED FOLDERS ON ANOTHER COMPUTER

Use the **net view** command to view shared resources located on another computer. To view shared folders on another computer, open a command prompt and run the following command.

```
net view computer
```

For example:

```
net view d820
```

You can identify **Computer** by using the computer name, host name, or IP address. If you receive an “**Access is denied**” error message when attempting to view shares on a remote computer, establish a **NetBIOS** connection to the remote computer.

For example, you could use **Net use** to establish a connection and then use **net view**, as the following example demonstrates.

```
net use \\win7 /user:username
```

```
net view \\win7
```
