

In the following tutorial , I'll show you how to quickly **Delete Internet Explorer Browsing History** via a command line. The cool part about **deleting your browsing history** via a command line, is that you can create simplex batch files to automate the entire process of clearing stored passwords, deleting [gs cookie]s, deleting history and files stored by the **Internet Explorer** browser.

The following has been tested to work with **Internet Explorer 7** and or **8**:

(HeelpBook Staff: this tip will work with Internet Explorer 9, too.)

How To Delete Internet Explorer Browsing History:

1. Click **Start -> Run**, type **cmd**, then click **Ok**
2. From the **Command Window**, type each of the following commands and press **Enter**:

To **Delete Temporary Internet Files**: Type

```
RunDll32.exe InetCpl.cpl,ClearMyTracksByProcess 8
```

To **Delete Cookies**: Type

```
RunDll32.exe InetCpl.cpl,ClearMyTracksByProcess 2
```

To **Delete History**: Type

```
RunDll32.exe InetCpl.cpl,ClearMyTracksByProcess 1
```

To **Delete Form Data**: Type

```
RunDll32.exe InetCpl.cpl,ClearMyTracksByProcess 16
```

To **Delete Passwords**: Type

```
RunDll32.exe InetCpl.cpl,ClearMyTracksByProcess 32
```

To **Delete ALL**: Type

```
RunDll32.exe InetCpl.cpl,ClearMyTracksByProcess 255
```

To **Delete Files and Settings Stored by addons**: Type

```
RunDll32.exe InetCpl.cpl,ClearMyTracksByProcess 4351
```
