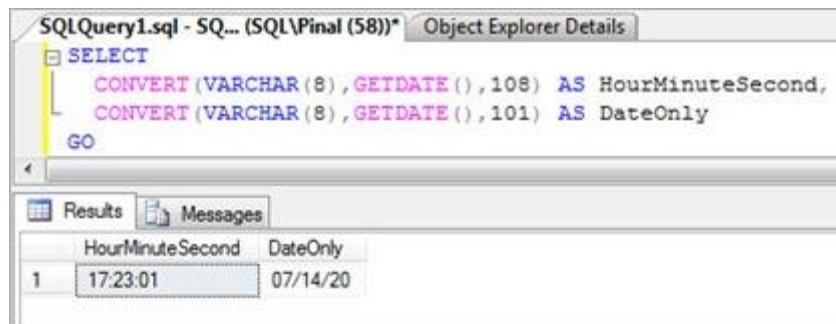


SQL Server - Get Date Part Only from Datetime

I have seen scores of expert developers getting perplexed with **SQL Server** in finding time only from datetime datatype. Let us have a quick glance look at the solution.

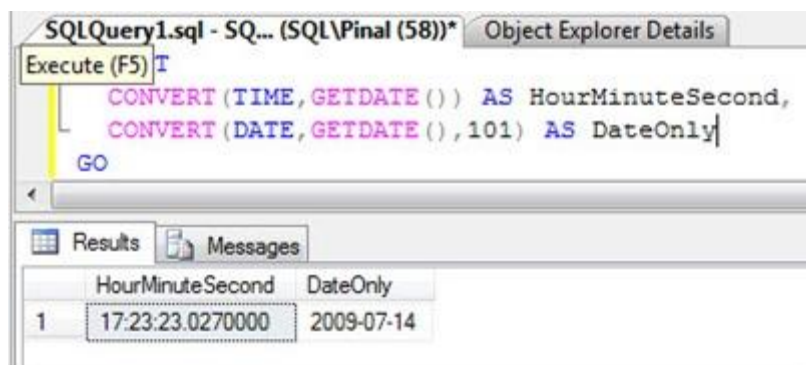
SQL Server 2000/2005

```
SELECT
CONVERT (VARCHAR (8), GETDATE (), 108) AS HourMinuteSecond,
CONVERT (VARCHAR (8), GETDATE (), 101) AS DateOnly
GO
```



SQL Server 2008

```
SELECT
CONVERT (TIME, GETDATE ()) AS HourMinuteSecond,
CONVERT (DATE, GETDATE (), 101) AS DateOnly
GO
```
