SQL SERVER – IS IT POSSBILE TO UPDATE DATA INSIDE A CLOB USING SQL?

CLOB, short for "Character Large **OB**ject", is a data type used to store and retrieve large amounts of text data in character format. A **CLOB** can store up to <u>128 terabytes</u> of character data in the database.

SCENARIO

I have a table having one clob column which has XML data in it. say i want to replace XYZ with ABC in **CLOB** column. Is it possible using sqlplus / T-SQL query?

SOLUTION

```
select * from [tables]
update [tables] set [field] = replace([field],'xml string', 'xml string
modiefied')
select * from [tables]
```
