
Visual Basic - VBA - How to declare a WorkSpace variable

SCENARIO:

I have Visual Basic 6.0

*I want to Dim a variable as **WorkSpace**.*

Been reading on it and wanted to check it out.

Anyway, it doesn't seem to be available. I have the Enterprise edition.

Any thoughts as to why it isn't an option?

Dim ws as WorkSpace...is not working.

SOLUTION

The solution is the following:

- Add a Reference to **Microsoft DAO3.x Object Library**;
- From **VBE (Visual Basic Editor)** go to **Project ---> References ---> Microsoft DAO3.x Object Library**;

Now you could use/declare a variable as workspace by writing:

```
Dim variable As DAO.Workspace
```

```
Dim variable As Workspace
```
