

## WINDOWS 7 – HOW TO DELETE HIBERFIL.SYS FILE

---

Hibernate mode uses the **hiberfil.sys** file to store the the current state (*memory*) of the PC, and since it's managed by Windows.

If you want to delete use one of the following solutions:

### Solution 1

- Click **Start -> All Programs -> Accessories**;
- Right-click **Command Prompt**;
- Select **Run as administrator**;
- Grant permission to change system settings;
- In this privileged command prompt window, enter:

```
powercfg -h off
```

### Solution 2

Boot in **Safe Mode** and delete the file. Ensure that the hibernation is not enabled. If you still cannot delete it, use some other bootable disk and then delete it.
