WordPress - How to manually upgrade

The following tutorial explains how to quickly upgrade **WordPress** to a newer version. The process is fairly straightforward and simple, however, I have frequently caught people including myself being lazy on an upgrade skipping important steps of the process.

I feel it's important to perform a manual **WordPress** upgrade and not auto upgrade using a utility like *fantastico*. While *fantastico* is an awesome tool for installing web applications, it has it's flaws when performing upgrades.

It's better to avoid the potential headache.

How to manually upgrade WordPress:

- 1. Perform a complete backup of both your database and directory structure (*in case something goes wrong*);
- 2. Login to your WordPress administration panel and deactivate all active plugins;
- 3. Download and extract the latest STABLE WordPresss version to a folder on your computer;
- 4. Upload the extracted files to your WordPress server directory with the *exception* of the following:
 - wp-content folder and it's content;

- wp-includes/languages if you are using a custom language file;
- 5. To perform the upgrade, navigate to **http://yoursitename/wp-admin/upgrade.php** and follow the on screen steps;
- 6. Login to the administration panel and reactivate your plugins one by one to ensure that they still work with the new version of **WordPress**.
